### SEAALL Scholarship Committee Annual Report 2000-20001

During 2000-2001, the Executive Board allocated \$5,000 for scholarships and the Scholarship Committee awarded \$4,600 to worthy recipients. The scholarship application was available on the chapter website and in the *SEAALL Newsletter*.

During the beginning of the year, the Committee discussed the requests for earmarking scholarship money for paraprofessional and law firm librarians. In my messages publicizing the scholarships, I stated that we were especially interested in funding law firm librarians and paraprofessionals, however, we did not specifically earmark portions of the money. We wanted to judge each application on its own merits.

We received six applications from newer law librarians. All applicants were awarded funds, however, Laurel Page Bell, was unable to use the funds to attend the SEAALL/SWALL meeting and she returned the check.

Laurel Page Bell – Parker, Poe, Adams and Bernstein - awarded \$800 to attend the SEAALL/SWALL meeting, but she was unable to accept it.

Ann-Marie Berti – University of North Carolina - \$500 to attend the SEAALL/SWALL meeting

Terrance Manion – Georgia State University - \$700 for law school tuition

Jennifer Sekula – William and Mary - \$1000 for library school tuition.

Jeanne Therese Ullian – Hofheimer Nusbaum - \$800 to attend the AALL meeting.

Christopher Vallandingham – University of Florida - \$800 for MLS tuition.
