In response, however belated, to your letter of November 21, I would like to comment on the issues raised:

1) I agree that "potential for staying in profession" is vague and could be eliminated. If employment record and educational background are important to us, we should address them more directly.

2) Agree with disqualification.

3) Old member is more than 3 years.

4) New member is less than 3 years.

5 & 6) I think the intent of this one is to "share the wealth" and I have no problem with it.

7 & 8) Form changes are all to the good. The more attractive, the better.

9) Good new wording.

You may recall that Claire Engel, now of Kilpatrick & Cody in Atlanta, spent almost an entire year revising these guidelines 2-3 years back. She may be able to address some of your questions and concerns and explain why some things are worded as they are.
