Enclosed you will find information about the 1991-1992 Lucile Elliott Scholarship program with the guidelines and an application form. Those of you who have not paid your annual SEAALL membership dues will also find a dues reminder form.

For the second year, a total of \$3,000.00 will be made available to members through the Lucile Elliott Scholarship program. The amounts of the awards granted will be based on need and the actual cost of the activity for which the applicant is seeking assistance.

Last year the eight recipients used their awards to further their professional development by such activities as attending the SEAALL annual meeting, the AALL annual meeting, a government document seminar, and for tuition for a MLS program.

To insure that Chapter members will have the broadest possible window of opportunity to secure assistance for activities including the AALL Mid-Winter Institute in February, the completed applications must be returned by November 21, 1991. Winners will be notified by December 16, 1991.

If the application form does not provide enough space to respond, please feel free to attach an additional sheet. You may also include other information you feel is relevant to your application. Please read carefully the "Lucile Elliott Scholarship Guidelines" printed on the reverse of this notice for the criteria the Committee will use in evaluating your application.

Recipients of this award will be asked to report on how their scholarship money was used, and may be asked to write a brief article for the Chapter newsletter describing their experience.
