CONTRIBUTORS

James D. Birchfield, Assistant Director of Libraries for Collection Development, was formerly Assistant Curator of the John MacKay Shaw Collection at Florida State University and Curator of Rare Books at the University of Kentucky.

John Clubbe, Professor of English at the University of Kentucky, has published books on nineteenth-century figures, among them Thomas Hood, Carlyle, and Byron.

Kevin S. Kiernan is Professor of English at the University of Kentucky, where he was named University Research Professor for 1983-84. He is the author of two books, Beowulf and the Beowulf Manuscript (Rutgers, 1981; rpt. 1984) and The Thorkelin Transcripts of Beowulf (Rosenkilde and Bagger, 1986), and of many articles on Old and Middle English literature. He is currently preparing a new edition of Beowulf.

John Lihani is Professor of Spanish literature and Hispanic linguistics at the University of Kentucky. Being Slovak by birth, American by choice, Spanish by profession, he is all three by affection. A polyglot in over a dozen languages, author of scores of articles and several books, he has worked extensively on medieval and Renaissance Spanish literature and linguistics.

W. Hugh Peal (1898-1984) graduated from the University of Kentucky in 1922. As a Rhodes Scholar he studied law at Exeter College, Oxford from 1922 to 1925. He is best remembered as an important collector of nineteenth-century British literature, especially of the Romantic period.
