Colombians Pablo Escobar and Jorge Ochoa are leaders of the Medellin Cartel, which is responsible for the cocaine entering the U.S. Escobar, known as "El Patrón," is a former car thief and gun for hire who founded his own organization in 1977 and is now believed to be the world's richest criminal. He provides security (and is a member of the police force) for the Cartel. Ochoa, middle-aged and notorious Ochoa clan, once bragged of possessing 4,000 pounds of cocaine a week. The money generated from the sale of cocaine, in excess of \$1 billion a day, enable the Cartel to buy influence in Panama's General Manuel Noriega, to allow the cartel to use Panama's airports and banks for profits through Panama's banking system. (He received \$200,000 a year from the CIA.)

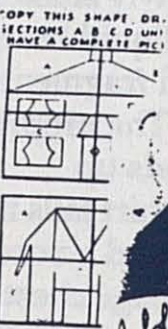

Lieutenant Colonel Richard Gadd retired in 1982 after 20 years of service in covert operations.
