Dear Lumpkin:-

Your letter of the 14th relative to the used copies of N.C. Reports has been received.

I note that you wish copies of each volume from 1 N.C. through 57 N.C. The reason I wrote in some detail previously was to let you know that we did not have duplicate extra copies of all of the volumes you wish. I have again checked all of the extra duplicates not in active use, in an effort to assist you.

We can supply you with copies of each volume from 1 N. C. through 57 N.C. except the following: 8, 18, 38, 46, 50, 51. Each of the volumes we can supply is in excellent used condition, except 19, 55, and 56, all of which are bound in calf and are badly rubbed; there is a small tear across the edge of volume 19, but each of the three volumes is in usable condition.

It seems to me that fair prices for the above volumes would be the following: For ~~19, 55,~~ and 56 - 75¢ each; for the remaining 48 volumes - \$1.25 each. This would total \$62.25. If you wish, while you are here getting these volumes, you can purchase from the Bob Alley, the Land Grant Clerk who handles the sale of new Reports for the State, new copies of 8, 18, 38, 46, 50, and 51 - at \$2.00 each - for \$12.00. This is merely a suggestion, of course, but if you follow this plan you will get the needed 57 volumes (51 used and 6 new) \$74.25. This same lot if purchased new would cost slightly more than \$114.00

You can get them here at the building any time next Monday, from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. or any time from 3:00 P.M. to 4:30 P.M. Tuesday, Wednesday of Thursday. If you come as late as Friday or Saturday, you can reach me any time until 12:30 Saturday. I am noting this peculiar schedule, because I will be tied up in Court during (the last week of argument) next week. If you will drop me a card as to when to expect you (approximately), I will try to ~~thru~~ get the books wiped off and tied up in small bundles for easier handling.
