Dear Bill:

Enclosed in a copy of a letter I sent to Morris Cohen along with a check for \$221.57. I understand that Jon sent you a copy of his accounting, which I don't feel amounted to anything, and the information that AALS would contribute \$50.00 toward this expense. I feel we should accept this and then consider very strongly future meetings. Few of our people attend any of AALS meetings and here we are paying a full registration which goes toward their expenses. Much of this year's expenses were also paid by contributions from law book dealers which reduced their expenses by that much.

I think possibly one of the reasons this has not come up in the past is that we have never had any speakers for which we had to pay so much expenses. Maybe this is what we need to avoid. All of this is something I think needs some real consideration.

After paying any current bills we have a balance of \$950.32. I have no idea what kind of expenses are anticipated for the institute, but it is about time for me to be getting bills out again for 1975/76 dues.
