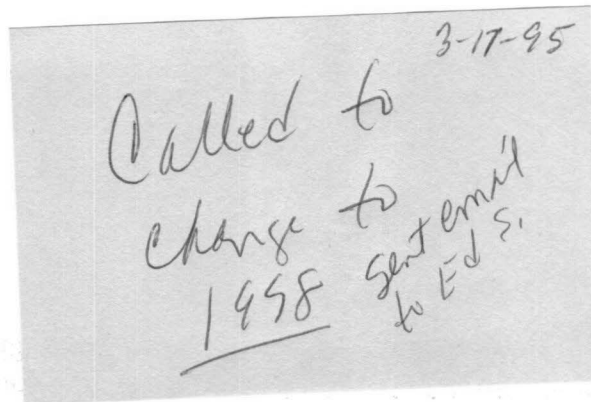

Dear Carol:

As I told you in our telephone conversation Wednesday, the New Orleans chapter of the American Association of Law Libraries voted Tuesday, February 21, to offer to host the annual meeting/conference for the Southeastern Association of Law Libraries in 1997.

We plan to present our motion to offer at the 1995 SEAALL business meeting in April in Richmond, Va. Please let me know before that meeting if our motion needs to be in writing or be made by one of our officers (I'm not sure if any are coming?).

As I told you on the phone, we would try to coordinate our meeting with Mardi Gras in New Orleans. I believe that the festive and unique atmosphere would be very inviting for SEAALL members, especially those who have never experienced it. We would like for the SEAALL Executive Committee to consider NOALL's hosting SEAALL's annual conference either the weekend before Mardi Gras Tuesday (Thursday, Feb. 6 - Saturday, Feb. 9, 1997) or the weekend before that (Thursday, Jan. 30 - Saturday, Feb. 1, 1997).

I have already contacted several hotels in downtown New Orleans. Most of them would provide guest rooms, meeting space, and catering service on either or both of those weekends.

If neither of the above dates is acceptable to the Executive Committee, then they could consider holding the conference in conjunction with the Jazz Festival (end of April - first of May) or with "Fiesta" downtown celebration with street bands, foods, etc. (sometime in Spring
