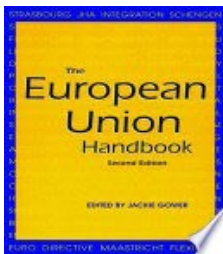

## EU Publications in Young Library

The William T. Young Library is a depository for European Union publications, which allows it to automatically receive a copy of most documents by the EU. The items in this collection range from a variety of subjects including policy developments, demographics, agriculture, transportation, energy, and economics. You can search our holdings through the library catalog for both print and electronic resources.

To search for publications in the catalog type in European Union and limit to the subject you are interested in. Limit you results to *Available in the library*

*Example:* Information on the European refugee crisis.

Type European Union in the first box and refugee in the second box. Limit you results to: Available in the library and publication date of last two years.

The EU print collection can be found on the fifth floor of Young Library in the North Wing at the following range of call numbers:

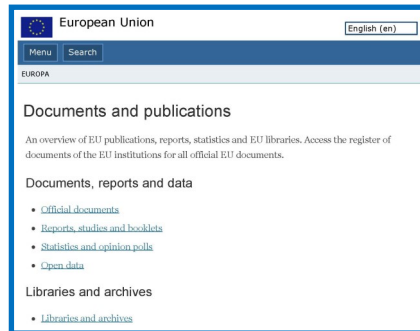

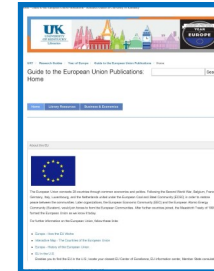
